



## EDU 280 G.E.T.S. Model Worksheet

Dear student,

You are receiving this document because you are enrolled in EDU 280 (Education Field Experience) this upcoming semester. As you know, students enrolled in EDU 280 must complete 50 hours of observation in a classroom environment that is consistent with your ultimate certification goal. Students must divide the 50 hours between two settings, where one setting has students with disabilities. There is no set number of hours in each setting, thus, speak to your cooperating school districts to figure out the best way to divide your hours.

In order to find the most suitable placements, please use the G.E.T.S. Model. The G.E.T.S. Model will help you connect your career preferences to which types of settings you should observe within. Remember, the settings must be consistent with your certification goals and must include one setting that has students with disabilities.

Before you identify a placement with a local school district, copy, paste, and complete the G.E.T.S. form below so your professor can confirm you are requesting a placement consistent with state and college standards. Once you complete the form, please attach it to a post in “My Journal” on Campus Cruiser so you and your professor can communicate as needed.
