Dear Student:

New Jersey State law requires that all college students carrying 12 or more credits and 30 years of age and younger must prove immunity to Measles, Mumps and Rubella and Hepatitis B. You must submit proof of immunizations or proof that you qualify for an exemption to the Health Services Office, South II, Room 109. Failure to comply with this requirement will prevent you from registering full time for your second semester.

All students carrying 12 or more credits 30 years of age and younger are required to submit to the Health Services Office a record of immunization against measles, mumps and rubella and Hepatitis B. Your immunization record may be obtained from your personal physician, military records or from your high school. These records need to be mailed in or dropped off at our Office in South II. We cannot accept records via fax. Failure to comply with this requirement will prevent you from registering for your next semester.

Required immunizations are:

1. Measles (2): The first dose must have been given after 1968 and after your first birthday. The second dose must have been given at least 30 days after the first dose.
2. Mumps (1): Given after your first birthday.
3. Rubella (1): Given after your first birthday.
The vaccine may have been given for each disease separately, or it may have been given in combination form (MMR).
4. Hepatitis B (3): A series of three shots given over a six-month period.

Acceptable proof can be: (1) A record from your physician; or (2) A school record; or (3) A public health department document. The proof must be a document that specifies month, day and year of immunizations or the results of blood tests showing immunity to each one of the diseases (measles, mumps and rubella) and hepatitis. Your name and birthdate must be on the record. Please include your student number if you have one.

Exemptions are allowed. They must be certified as prescribed by law. They are:

1. Medical reasons, such as immunosuppression, pregnancy or allergic reaction to neomycin; or
2. Religious beliefs.

Please return proof of immunization or documentation of exemption along with your name and student identification number to Health Services, South II, Room 109. The MMR and Hepatitis B vaccines are available at the MCC Health Office for a fee. If you have already submitted your *completed* record, please disregard this notice.
