

Policies at Rutgers University – New Brunswick area campuses Concerning transferability of certain courses – dependent upon how that course was presented at MCC

- ECO 201 + 202** Must meet on-campus / in a classroom / for at least 4 weeks to be granted credit from the New Brunswick Economics department.
- HIS (all of them)** Must meet on-campus / in a classroom / to be granted transfer credit toward the major in History.
- MAT 129 +higher** Must meet on-campus / in a classroom / for at least 5 weeks.
- MAT 123 + 124** May be used as: equivalent to **01:830:200 – Quantitative Methods in Psychology** (a core course requirement of a Psychology major) or as **01:960: 211, 212 Statistics I & II** for other majors (but note : Statistics at Rutgers is not counted as a math course so it has no time requirements) or as **01:640:104 + 01:960:212 – Elementary Combinatorics & Probability + Statistics II** -> in which case **MAT 123** is viewed as a math course and must be at least 5 weeks while **MAT 124** is a statistics which has no time restriction.
- PSY (all of them)** Must meet on campus / in a classroom / for at least 4 weeks.
