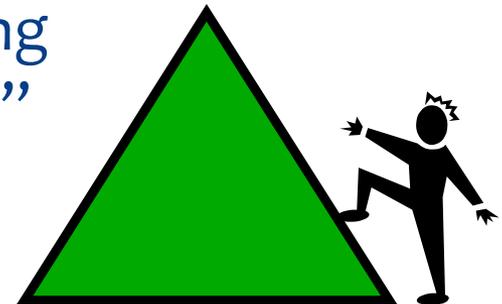


# Engaging Students with APPs in the Classroom

- \* Benjamin S. Bloom – Author of 18 books, Taxonomy translated into 22 languages, one of the most often cited references in education
- \* **Learning does not happen by chance.** This taxonomy categorizes levels of questions (thinking) from the simplest to the most complex. Are we helping students “climb to a higher level of thought?”

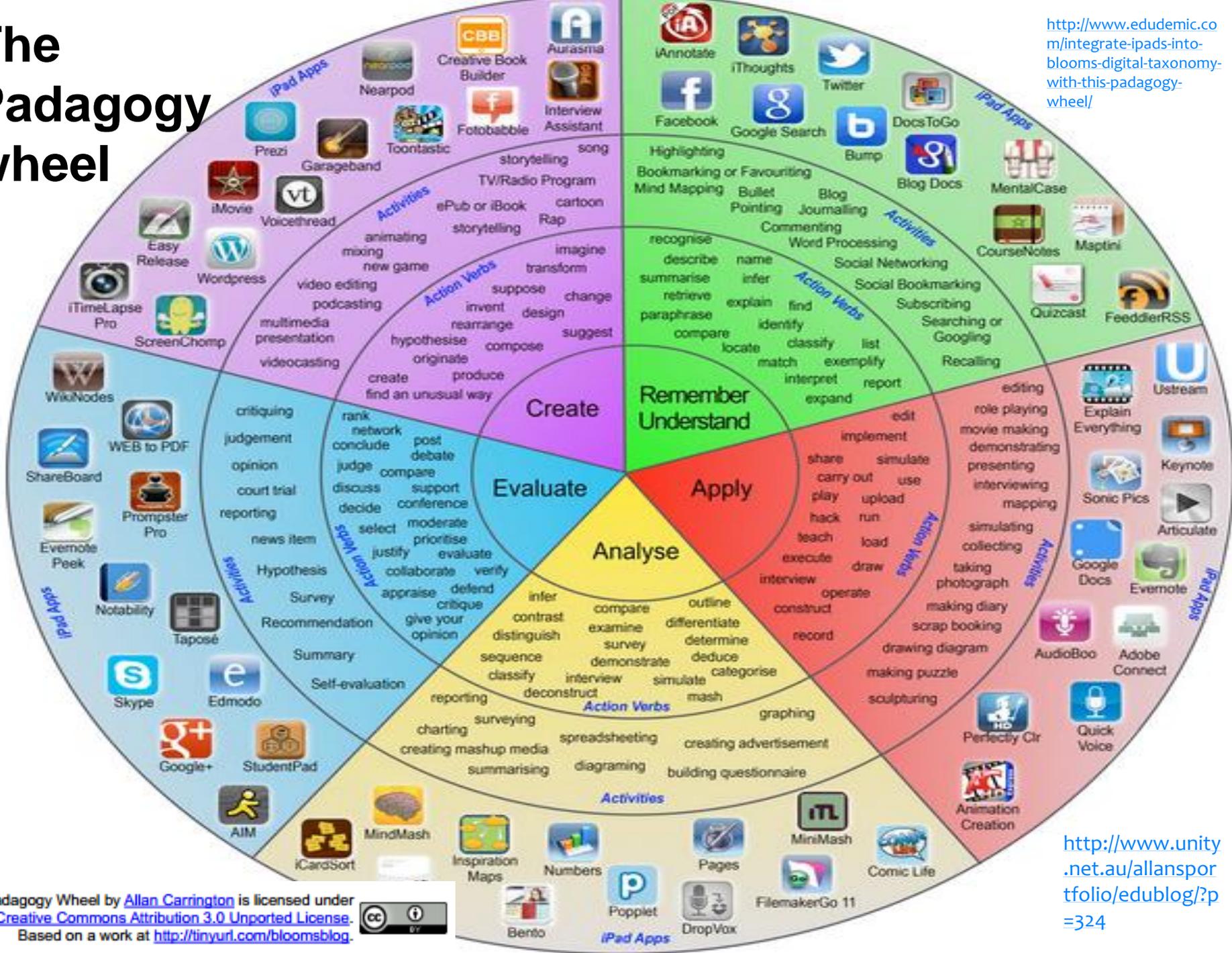
