## How to Make an Appointment in the Dental Hygiene Clinic

Please call (732) 906 2536 to make an appointment in the Middlesex County College Dental Hygiene Clinic.

- Thank you for considering the Middlesex County College Dental Hygiene clinic for your preventive dental services.
- Please keep in mind that our clinic is in an educational setting.
- Dental hygiene services are provided by students under the direct supervision of licensed dentists and dental hygienists.
- If you are a **new patient (18 years and older)**, the first step is to schedule a **screening appointment**.
- The screening appointment is FREE
- The screening appointment is for filling out a medical history and a brief examination of your mouth, performed by our faculty, to determine your dental needs. **You will NOT receive a cleaning at this visit!**
- At the completion of the screening appointment we can schedule your appointments with a student for further treatment.
- Accepting an appointment with a student is a commitment to that student that you will arrive promptly for your scheduled appointments and fulfill your obligation to that student by staying the required 3 1/2 hours. If your treatment cannot be completed in one visit you will need to return returning for continuing care
- The cost for dental hygiene treatment is \$20 for an adult, \$5 for a senior citizen (65 or older), MCC Students, Faculty and Staff, and \$10 for children and teens.
