PROGRAM INFORMATION

- The High School Scholars Program provides high school students the opportunity to earn Middlesex County College credit while still in high school.
- Students who have completed at least one marking period in 9th grade may enroll for courses for which they meet pre-requisites by filling out the application, obtaining proper signatures, and submitting the completed application with payment to MCC for registration. Please make checks payable to Middlesex County College.
